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The airbrushing make-up course begins with an introduction to the products within the Airbase Professional Make-Up range. The product is demonstrated in detail on a model and then students get the opportunity to take a make-up airbrush in their hands and give it a go themselves on each other. Students will also be shown how to dismantle the airbrush and then go on to do it themselves. Techniques on concealing and highlighting will be taught.

A short test will be conducted at the end. Upon successful and satisfactory completion of all sections of the course, a certificate and badge will be issued as evidence of proficiency in application of Airbase Airbrush Make-Up.
